1. Introduction

- 1.1. SOUTHERN ALSATIAN TRAINING SOCIETY (SATS) is committed to protecting your personal information and respecting your privacy.

6. How we will use information about you

6.1 We will generally process your personal data for contractual necessity in providing membership services and for managing events. We may also use personal information for additional relevant and related purposes where you might reasonably expect us to do so, where the benefits of doing so are not outweighed by your own interests or fundamental rights or freedoms.

7. Recipients of Data

- 7.1 We may use service providers to help us provide you with our services e.g. compilation of catalogues for KC licenced events. Personal data may be transferred to such a service provider, who acts for or on our behalf, for further processing in accordance with the purpose(s) for which the data was originally collected or may otherwise be lawfully processed.
- 7.2 In appropriate circumstances we may disclose data to authorised bodies as required by law.

Where do we obtain your personal data from?

Most of the above personal data is received direct from you (the data subject). However, information may be received from third parties e.g. Kennel Club, Societies / Clubs with purposes in common with SATS.

How long do we hold your personal data for?

Personal data will be retained in accordance with statutory requirements, Kennel Club requirements and recommendations.

Are you obliged to provide us with your personal data?

You are not obliged to provide the personal data in question. However, if you do not provide the personal data, we will be unable to perform any contract we have with you for the provision of membership services, judging appointments or event services.

Recipients of your personal data

In line with section 7 of our main Privacy Policy, we disclose data to the following:

- Printers for compilation and production of show and trials catalogues
- The Kennel Club—to hold the personal data of officers of SATS as a part of the implementation of Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
- The Kennel Club notification of Challenge Certificate winners at our events and competitor / exhibitor results, submitted through marked catalogues; this is in order to comply with requirements in the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Do we use your data for any automated decision-making?
