SATS CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TRAINING SESSIONS

SATS requires all Members to comply with the following Code of Conduct when attending Training Events hosted by SATS.

- You **MUST** respect other Members and their dog's space. Do not allow your dog to approach a person or another dog without the owner's permission. (Your dog's idea of fun may be another person's or dog's worst nightmare).
- All dogs must be on a lead unless working.
- You must clean up after your dog and take the bags home.
- Do not bring your dog onto the field if it is unwell, or if it is a bitch in season. (Most seasons last at **LEAST** 21 days).
- Owners are responsible for all aspects of their dog's behaviour.
 SATS cannot be held liable for any incident occurring on the training field, in the car park or related areas, either during or after training.
- Any grievance or problems that occur in any SATS training session must be raised with the organisers at the time of occurrence or at the earliest opportunity thereafter.
- Committee Members will endeavour to address any grievance at the earliest opportunity.
- No postings in respect of SATS may be published on social media without the express permission of SATS.
- Failure to comply with the Code of Conduct may result in exclusion from training and withdrawal of your Membership.
